



Glenn Zaleski, Piano

Glenn Zaleski is one of the leading up-and-coming voices in the New York jazz scene. Originally from Boylston, MA, Glenn has made a name for himself playing with the likes of Ravi Coltrane, Lage Lund, and Ari Hoenig. His debut album, "My Ideal", was released in March of 2015. Downbeat Magazine named it "sublime", JazzTimes called it, "an engaging set by a talent worth watching," and the NYTimes said, "a strong statement", praising its "fluent but unhurried sense of phrase".

He's also released two recordings with the collective, Stranahan/Zaleski/Rosato as well as a duo record with his brother, saxophonist Mark Zaleski. ("Duet Suite", 2010). In 2011, Glenn was a semi-finalist in the Thelonious Monk International Jazz Piano Competition, as well as a finalist for the 2011 APA Cole Porter Fellowship in Jazz. He attended the Brubeck Institute Fellowship program in Stockton, CA from 2005-2007, and then finished his undergraduate studies at The New School in 2009. From 2009-2011, while working towards his graduate degree at NYU, Glenn was also on NYU faculty, teaching a variety of classes and private students.
